Terms & Conditions:-

1. That the C.E shall Odisha Clinical Establishment (Control and Regulation) abide by the provisions of the Act 1990, rules made there under.
2. That for renewal, application shall be made to the authority not less than six months it's before expiry.
3. Any Change in the constitution or management of the clinical establishment shall be intimated later than fifteen days to the supervising authority along with the original certificate for issue of new one.
4. Any change of staff of the Clinical Establishment must be reported to the Supervising Authority within one month of such change.
5. All Certificates of the establishment including OSPCB, Fire Safety, Trade License, Rate chart, Name of Staff on duty etc., must be displayed in a prominent place for viewing of public information.
6. No drugs shall be used in the establishment unless purchased with authorized bill from a licensed Manufacturer and seller and should be handled only by the registered pharmacist in compliance with provision of Section 42 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
7. The Registration Certificate Holder shall comply with provisions of the Orissa Establishment (Control & Regulation) Act 1990 and Amendment Rules 2006 made there under for time being in force.
